## Empowering a Domestic Violence Survivor to Attain Safety and Financial Stability

Escaping an abusive marriage takes courage and a network of support. Maggie Cartwright,\* a mother of two young children, knew that she had to protect her children from her abusive husband. She tried separating from him, but he continued to attack her physically. At one point, he seriously injured her and put her in the hospital. Committed to protecting her children, Mrs. Cartwright contacted legal aid.

Mrs. Cartwright's legal aid attorney helped her divorce her abuser and secure financial support to ensure that Mrs. Cartwright received both child and spousal support. Because of legal aid, Mrs. Cartwright not only obtained sole custody of her children so that she can keep them safe, but she also secured the financial means necessary to provide for them while she rebuilds their lives.
