Helping a Senior Recover from Fraud

When vulnerable seniors fall victim to sophisticated fraudsters, it can upend a lifetime of careful planning. Grace McCormick,* a Vietnam veteran who served in the Marines, owned her home and had prepared for her senior years. Sadly, Ms. McCormick fell into poor health and became homebound.

A fraudster preyed on Ms. McCormick's vulnerability and illegally transferred the deed to her home into his name, stealing her most significant asset and leaving her at risk of poverty and homelessness. Because the fraudster had died, neither Ms. McCormick nor Adult Protective Services knew how to restore Ms. McCormick's property or stability, so they reached out to legal aid for help.

Legal aid took action against the fraudster's estate and successfully restored Ms. McCormick's title to her name. Thanks to legal aid, Ms. McCormick's home is her own again, where she can remain safe and stably housed throughout the remainder of her senior years.
